Abuse and Harassment Policy

Clothing Policy

Concerns have surfaced regarding clothing that is a distraction in youth group. Because of this, we ask that members of AYM recognize that their words, actions and appearance during youth group contribute to the way we present ourselves to our peers and that we are ambassadors of the Annunciation faith community.

PLEASE DO NOT WEAR apparel that distracts from the youth group environment, including: tank tops, short shorts, visible undergarments, or any clothing with obscene, vulgar, abusive or discriminatory language or images. This includes apparel that advertises or promotes alcohol, chemicals, tobacco or any other products illegal for use by minors.
