How to Complete an MPS School Request

- **Gather Information:**
 - Visit the Online Request Center: schoolrequest.mpls.k12.mn.us to learn about placement options for Pre-K through grade 12.
 - Pick up a copy of the Pre-K-12 School Guide at any of our schools or either placement office:
Student Placement Center, 1250 W. Broadway, Minneapolis, MN 55411, or
New Families Center, 3345 Chicago Ave. S., Minneapolis, MN 55407
- Indicate your first and second choice schools on your request. Please call one of the placement centers if you have questions:
 - Student Placement Center at 612.668.1840 or the New Families Center at 612.668.3700.
 - Families who speak a home language other than English can call the New Families Center at 612.668.3700.
- Request forms must be received or postmarked on or before Feb. 8, 2019 to be included in the first round of school assignments. School assignment letters will be received in homes by March 29, 2019. A parent/guardian must sign the request form for it to be processed.
- High Five students attending their attendance area community school will be automatically enrolled in Kindergarten at that school. Others wishing to request Kindergarten must submit a request.
- Proof of address will be required for students who are new to MPS, have a new address, or are requesting an oversubscribed school.
- Please refer to the chart below to determine if you qualify for Educational Benefits (the free/reduced-price lunch program).
- You have the best chance of receiving your top school or program by requesting before the deadline of February 8, 2019

High Five Information

High Five is a preschool program for children who turn four on or by September 1 and who will start kindergarten the following fall. High Five primarily offers half-day enrollment, with limited full-day seats available. For more information, visit <http://ece.mpls.k12.mn.us>. High Five students must meet the following eligibility requirements to be eligible for consideration:

- Students must be at least four years old on or by September 1.
- Students must complete a preschool screening prior to the first day of school. Call 612.668.3715 to make an appointment.
- Priority placement will be given to students who qualify for Educational Benefits (the free/reduced-price lunch program).
- Priority placement will be given to Minneapolis residents.

Sliding Fee Scale for High Five

- The sliding fee scale establishes a recommended amount of payment for service based on family income and family size.
- No child will be excluded because of their family's inability to pay.
- The fee for High Five is waived for children who qualify for Educational Benefits (the free/reduced-price lunch program).
- Families who do not qualify for Educational Benefits (the free/reduced-price lunch program) will be charged based on a sliding-fee scale.
