

ART EXPLOSION!

Does your child love art? Your child will love exploring different art mediums while creating his or her next masterpiece! During this workshop, students will be introduced to, or reinforce, art concepts that will strengthen technique and explore creativity. The following art activities are designed for students entering 2nd-5th grades in Fall 2019.

Description

- Session #1 *Awesome Acrylics* **Wednesday, June 12th**
Students will be introduced to the power of color through painting! We will learn the basics of painting and how to mix paint colors to create powerful images using acrylic paint on canvas.
- Session #2 *Clay Creations* **Wednesday, June 19th**
Students will be introduced to sculpting tools and make a variety of objects out of different kinds of clay.
- Session #3 *Wonderful Watercolor* **Wednesday, June 26th**
Using high quality watercolor, students will create vibrant masterpieces and learn to use water to strengthen and dilute colors.
- Session #4 *Outstanding Origami* **Wednesday, July 10th**
Students will learn the art of paper folding and make different kinds of animals, flowers, and other mystery objects.
- Session #5 *Marvelous Mask-Making* **Wednesday, July 17th/*Friday, July 19th**
This class involves some teamwork, as students will be working together to make plaster masks of their faces! This one will be a bit messy! After they dry, students will be welcomed back for an extra hour to paint and decorate their masks.

Cost for each activity is \$50. No additional supplies or costs are needed. Location is at Annunciation Catholic School, room 204. Class size is limited, so please register today!
