



Summer STEM Activities

Do you have a curious child who would like to explore the mysterious world of science, technology, engineering, and math this summer? With Summer STEM Activities, students will work to explore different concepts—we may get a little messy, but we will be learning! We will be filling spots on a first come, first serve basis, so sign up today!

The following activities are designed for students entering 2nd -5th grades in Fall 2019.

Description

Session #1 *Glowing Liquids and Other Light Experiments*

Tuesday, June 11th

Students will learn how to make things glow and light up with a variety of different luminescent experiments.

Session #2 *Big Explosions and Other Bursting Things*

Tuesday, June 18th

Students will work with different ingredients and observe the results. We will make elephant toothpaste, bubbles with dry ice (with safety equipment, of course!), and design our own rockets!

Session #3 *Good-bye Gravity!*

Tuesday, June 25th

Students will learn how to fight the force of gravity. We will experiment to create the best paper airplane, make balloon hovercrafts and see what things we can get to float!

Session #4 *Cool Chemistry*

Tuesday, July 9th

Students will work with different substances and observe the results. We will experiment with invisible ink and make slime!

Session #5 *On the Move*

Tuesday, July 16th

Students will do a variety of experiments to explore how things move and what we can do to move them without effort. We'll try to get a ball to bounce to the moon—or at least higher than you'd expect—and make our own bouncy balls!
