ACADEMICS

Annunciation School is accredited by the Minnesota Non-Public School Accrediting Association and is a member of the National Catholic Education Association and the Minnesota Catholic Education Association.

We strive to provide the best possible education for our students. We employ teaching aides in kindergarten, first and second grades as well as specialists in computers, creative arts, physical education and a full-time librarian.

Students study Spanish in kindergarten through eighth grade.

Our curriculum goes beyond the conventional classroom by offering a variety of enrichment experiences to reach every type of learner. Each grade level enjoys unique experiences through field trips, creative arts productions, in-school arts programs, academic competitions and more.

Extracurricular activities include athletics, performing arts productions, on-site music lessons, scouts, various clubs and more.

Strong Christian values are threaded through the whole of our academic day. Our religious curriculum focuses on an understanding of Jesus Christ within the sacred scriptures, Catholic tradition and sacraments. We welcome students from all faiths.

Classes

Annunciation School offers kindergarten through eighth grade classes. There are two classes per grade with an average class size of 24 students.

Kindergarten

We offer both part-time kindergarten and full-time kindergarten. Our innovative offerings allow each family to choose the option that is best for them. Choose full-day every day, two or three full-days with the rest half-day, or begin the year with half-day every day. You may change your choice at the trimester breaks.

Extended Day Program

Provides quality care before and after school for students in grades K-8. Hours of operation are 7:00-7:50 a.m. and 2:25-6:00 p.m. This program is also provided over the summer and most holidays.

Student transportation

Students walk, bike or arrive by car. Many school families work together to carpool. We do not participate in the Minneapolis School bus system.
