OUR APPROACH TO RE-OPENING

IN-PERSON WITH ONLINE LEARNING AS NEEDED

We are looking forward to welcoming all students back on campus for in-person classes on August 31.

Our top priority is to provide our students with an excellent Catholic education while keeping everyone safe and healthy.

In developing our plan, our committee followed guidance from the Minnesota Department of Health, Centers for Disease Control, the Archdiocese and outside experts including a group of parents with medical, human resource, and mental health backgrounds. We also asked for input from our extended day program, which has safely been running in our school this summer. **THANK YOU to all the Safe Opening Committee Members and the Parent Review Group.**

HEALTH AND SAFETY

- All employees and students will be educated on proper handwashing techniques and respiratory etiquette.
- · All employees and students will wear a mask at all times while indoors and maintian social distance when outdoors.
- All desks will face the same direction and will be arranged in accordance with the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) Social Distance Guidelines.
- Flexible seating arrangements will be utilized in grade levels where feasible including floor seating with lap desks.
- Students will eat lunches in their classrooms or outside.
- All school lunches for purchase will be pre-packaged boxed lunches prepared by Agra Culture or students may bring a tree nut free lunch from home.
- Students will have their own school supplies and use of community supplies will be kept to a minimum. If using community supplies is unavoidable, designated bins will be used for clean and used supplies. Any used community supplies will be cleaned before put back into use.
- Equipment will not be shared between students whenever feasible. Any shared equipment will be cleaned between uses.
- · Specialist staff will rotate to program spaces versus rotating kids through the building as much as possible.
- Specialist lessons will be held outside as much as possible.
- \cdot We are exploring ways to safely continue our tradition of weekly Mass and Adoration.
- \cdot High touch surfaces will be cleaned frequently and between different groups of students.
- Procedures are in place for students/staff who become ill at or away from school, or are in contact with someone with COVID-19. *More information to come as we get closer to the school year.*

Classroom Arrangement: Desks will face the same direction & be in accordance with the MDH Social Distance Guidelines. Flexible seating & outdoor learning will be utilized when possible.



Sanitizing Stations: Will be located throughout the school and in all classrooms. Students must also bring their own.



Extracurriculars Activites: We will work with SSYO to determine protocols to safely convene school sports.



Movement on Campus: Traffic flow patterns and physical distancing will be utilized as well as minimal movement of classrooms.



Lunch: Students will eat pre-packaged boxed lunches prepared by Agra Culture or a tree nut free home lunch in their classrooms or outside.



Group Gatherings: No large group gatherings in the Gymnasium or Auditorium. When feasible, livestreaming into individual classrooms may be an alternative.



Masks: Must be worn indoors at all times in accordance with Governor Walz's Executive Order 20-81.



Mass: We are exploring ways to safely continue our tradition of weekly Mass and Adoration.



Transportation: We will have no busing. Field trips are suspended at this time. We will utilize virtual field trips when possible.



Drop off and pick up: Will continue to happen at the South Foyer. Only students will be allowed to enter the school.



Recess: Will continue to have outdoor recess without masks. Students will be divided into different areas for social distancing.



Visitors: We are limiting visitors, guests & volunteers at this time. If must enter the school, check in via the front office only.
