We were informed that no funds are currently set aside for these types of expenses, but that the school administration would look into this issue and try to find a solution.

Principal's Report – Prin. Zobel's report highlighted the changes at Annunciation, including
the remodeled fifth grade classrooms (to be ready just after school starts), the new
preschool playground, the school's centennial, the new hires on staff, the Peace of Mind
Initiative, and the Middle School updates, including the decoration team and the science
lab.

Enrollment update (no COVID update as Christy McFadden is not available) – Still getting
inquiries and hosting tours; Pre-K is very close to adding back a third classroom; long
discussion about low kindergarten enrollment at Annunciation. ASC was informed that
kindergarten enrollment is low in Minneapolis and across the Archdiocese.
