 - Aide changes

 - Using outside vendor for accounting (PASC)
 - Hiring for Director of School Nutrition
 - Signed contract with Cristo Rey. Will have one student intern 4 days per week
 - Hole in One Campaign Campaign and Auction was a great success. Bathroom plumbing issues surfaced in the past week and email has been sent out.

 - 1. Facility/Campus Environment & Security- New signage almost complete. Windows installed over spring break. Final asphalt and striping to be completed this summer.

 - 4. Marketing/Events & Enrollment See above
 - 5. Strategic Long Term Planning -
 - Survey (5th year) had 111 responses, which was in increase from the previous 3 years. Numeric results were essentially equal to 2024 data.
 - Themes
 - Largest numeric increase seen in communicating expectations of behavior, sharing student assessment in an understandable way, keeping parents apprised of the strategic improvement, and handbook provides useful information.
 - Largest numeric decrease seen in representing our defined mission, preparing students to be proficient users of technology, satisfactorily addressing issues of race and diversity.
 - Regarding the quality of communication, rates were lower and comments generally less positive than prior years
 - As in previous years, respondents support greater accessibility for people with disabilities.
