III. General Reports 6:40-7:15pm

- Principal's Report Principal DeBoer
 - Whole School and Parish update
 - 100% of staff returned to work, they are still working through and supporting each other
 - Washburn held a workshop for staff today after student's early release at 1:00pm.
 - We are now entering phase two of our process in returning to school and getting into more normal learning routines for students. We are continuing to need the support of our school parents throughout these phases.
 - Hiring subs to be available when needed for the whole school, most are retired or previous teachers from Annunciation, so are familiar to students.
 - Looking into Federal grants for schools that survive violence (via MDE), mainly for hiring subs and working with facilities, the grants are similar to a homeland security grant.

- Grant was submitted but the school has not heard back yet.
- Could look at getting a grant through private funders.
- The short term plan is 5 years for hiring new individuals, the school will need to wait and see what the government will fund.
- After MEA break, students will complete testing (2 out of 3 that is typically offered).
 - The tests are adaptable by how much schooling the students have had.
 - It's important to get that data.
 - Need baselines for where we are, will help with funding in the future.
- Sheila is working on a potential academic summer program from a project serve grant.
- Making progress for getting special education services on-site for students who qualify.
- Washburn is scaling back next week from 7 to 8 therapists per day to 4 on site.
 - Staff has been helping with self regulating emotions.
 - Will bring back reinforcements when needed, ex; when mass begins again in early November in the auditorium.
 - Moving to more structured and planned support.
- The Christmas program and Middle School Musical will continue.

 - SWAG store; creating Annunciation only apparel/goods for school families.
 - We had 50 attendees at last week's APO meeting; the most in the last 8 years!
 - Community Events Funding
 - Entrance fees for trivia night, father/daughter, etc.
 - Father/Daughter dance is proposed for February 28th (awaiting approval)
 - Action for next meeting: confirm committee rosters and figuring out next steps.
 - Parent focused events (e.g. santa event, father/daughter)
 - o For enrichment classes offered by outside businesses.
 - Can APO approve or does it need to be school leadership?
 - Process for school space usage approval?
 - Do instructors need to be VIRTUS trained?
 - Task force recap (from last Friday)
 - Shared what APO typically accomplishes in a "standard year"
 - Submitted funding ask (\$\$\$) to accomplish projected tasks.
 - Target is offering a minimum of \$250 per teacher to get anything they need from their website.
