## **Students Score 36 on ACT**

In 2014, high school students that scored a perfect 36 on their ACT college entrance exam numbered 10,000 in the US and 769 in the state of Minnesota. That means less than .5% of all students who take the test achieve such a score. Our very own Annunciation graduates from the class of 2010, Fiona Daley and Connor Plunkett, are among that elite group of students. What's the secret? Connor's advice is simple and practical—"Get a good night's sleep, eat a good breakfast and bring some good food along for a snack. Bring a coke, stay calm and pace yourself." Fiona added, "I took the entire practice test once and timed myself. I think that familiarity helped." Neither of them took any of the prep classes offered by tutoring services.

Dear Friends of Annunciation, Near and Far Away:

Annunciation School successfully reached major mile-posts during the 2013-2014 academic school year. First, this past spring, Annunciation School was visited by a team of educators from the Minnesota Non-Public Accrediting Association (MNSAA). We received notification in June of our renewal of accreditation through MNSAA. This renewal validates the work of our school and reviews all areas – mission, curriculum, instruction, school environment, facilities, policies and more. The MNSAA accreditation affirms our belief that we are providing a strong, Catholic education for our students with rigor and high standards for all.

Much preparation went into the creation of a school strategic plan which provided the foundation for the accreditation process. This plan has a 7-year lifespan until the next time accreditation renewal occurs. For two years prior to the visit by the MNSAA team, school staff,

parents and parish leaders met and worked together to review research, conduct surveys, and evaluate new ideas to build this plan for our future. Participants discussed major areas of focus and shared new ideas and visions for our school. Because of their visioning, Annunciation School is truly positioned to become a leader in Catholic education and challenge our students to reach their full potential.

Fiona is a graduate of DeLaSalle High School and Connor is a graduate of St. Thomas Academy. When asked how Annunciation School helped them prepare for high school, they had some ready answers. "Mrs. Skala, our librarian, allowed me to spend recess time in the library. I preferred reading over the playground and I believe, in part, that my success is due to fact that I read with speed and greater comprehension," explained Fiona. Connor said there were two classes that helped him in high school. "In Creative Writing our assignments had no boundaries. We were supposed to write about whatever we wanted to express. I think this helped develop skills in critical thinking." He added, "In high school speech class and on the debate team, other kids were nervous and had stage fright, I didn't. That was because of our experience in Creative Arts. We were accustomed to being on the stage, speaking in front of others and performing publically. It was a huge help in preparing us for these kinds of situations in high school."

Our two young scholars also had some advice to offer. Connor, who will be attending University of Chicago with an emphasis of study in Physics, said, "It's great to get a score of 36 but that score is not the most important thing when it comes to getting selected by the college of your choice. Colleges look at a composite of factors: test scores, high school grades, essays, AND legacy. Having a relative who is an alum can matter." Fiona will be attending Cornell University in Ithaca, New York and agreed with Connor. "There were several schools I applied to where I was not accepted. High school seniors should apply to several schools and know that wherever they are accepted it will be good," wise words from Fiona Daley. Good luck to you two and all the 2014 high school graduates!

## 2014 New York City Fund-A-Need \$\$'s for School Science

Donations from the 2014 Live and Silent Auction are earmarked to upgrade and expand the middle school science lab and instructional programming for students grades K-8. New science lab tables have been installed in the middle school classroom. New materials will be purchased to facilitate science study, research and experimentation. In process is the creation of our own "Science House" with supplies and kits for science curriculum for students of all grades. Providing students with hands-on experiences brings learning to life. When children are engaged in learning in an authentic way, they retain more knowledge and deepen their understanding of key concepts, an ultimate goal of high performing education.

Annunciation School is grateful for the enthusiasm and hard work of many volunteers whose efforts over the years have contributed to the growing momentum of the Annunciation Live and Silent Auctions. The first ever auction held in 2001, humbly titled "Annunciation School Live and Silent Auction" resulted in raising \$21,485 dollars to support the school. 
