
As our students grow through inquiry and discover learning, making real-world connections, they truly reach their full potentiality. Each child discovering who they are called to be and how they can make an impact on the world.

A Message from Fr. Park

Praying as a Family

(All families need God. Every single one. We need His help, His strength, His blessing, His mercy and His forgiveness.

It takes simplicity. To pray as a family, simplicity is needed. As a family, you can pray the 'Our Father' around the dinner table. That's not difficult to do, it's easy. Praying the rosary together, as a family is very beautiful and it gives strength. Also praying for one another: A husband for his wife and a wife for her husband. Parents praying for their children and children for their parents and grandparents. Praying for one another.

When speaking about the duties of parents, the Catechism of the Catholic Church states that "parents have the mission of teaching their children to pray and to discover their vocation as children of God." (CCC 2226) One of the greatest gifts parents can give to their children is to teach them how to pray, and one of the best ways to teach children about prayer is to model it by praying as a family. Remember that old expression – "the family that prays together stays together" – well, it's still true today!

Praying as a family does not have to be complicated, and it doesn't need to take a lot of time, but setting aside some time for family prayer is essential for Christian families. Maybe your family has a good routine of family prayer already established, great! Keep it up! Maybe your family takes some time for prayer during Advent and Lent, great! Can you find ways to expand your family prayer throughout the year? Maybe your family doesn't ever pray together, well, it's never too late to start a good thing! **Here are some simple, practical ways that you can pray as a family:**

- · Pray a blessing for each child before bedtime
- Do a short bible study, study of virtue, etc.
- Lay hands on and pray for a kid going through a particularly hard time

- Praying the Rosary (or decade for young kids)
- · Pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet
- Have each person say a short thanksgiving and/or intention
- · Singing a praise song or hymn together
- · Read a story about a saint
- Create a sacred space, using candles, liturgical colors, holy images or icons to show that this time is special. Have your kids help set it up, and use your senses to pray with your whole body!
- In the car, you can listen to praise and worship, sung prayers, saint stories, etc. (or Father Park's Podcast :)
- Stop to say a short prayer at a certain time of day, such as the Angelus at noon or "Jesus I trust in You" at 3pm, the hour of mercy.
- Celebrate your children's Baptism Days It's their birthday into the family of God! Recite baptismal promises, have their favorite meal
- Celebrate the Liturgical Seasons with special traditions
- Celebrate other feast days throughout the year with parties (and some prayers! Holy Days of Obligation require going to Mass, but there should be some feasting that go along with it!)


