# **Enrollment Committee Report**

#### **EVENTS:**

**MS OPEN HOUSE-FEB 6**<sup>TH-</sup>FB event went live last night via CSCOE, postcards mailed, Mail Chimp to all current families & toured families. Will add Parish families too.

**PK-1**<sup>ST</sup> **WINTER FUN FEST**-meets a CSCOE grant goal to provide a non-recruiting based event. Flyer went out. Mail chimp to follow to toured families as well as LADC/Parish list too.

Looking at options to work w/LADC for some other events after Mass too.

#### **INITIATIVES:**

**FB**, **Google and Remarketing is live** with 5 separate ads. 3-Directed at lower grades 2-MS directed. We will target surrounding zip codes and appropriate age groups. We are working w/Hot Dish Advertising (Jen Campbell's company) to make sure things are in order and accurate.

**BILLBOARD**-currently up on 50<sup>th</sup> and Penn until end of month. Currently no other boards are booked

**Social Media Grant:** Continue monthly meetings w/goal of increasing our social media following and getting "free" follow up advertising for the school. We need to tell our story! It's meant to be a slow process to eval what works. We have gained 68 followers since Sept/starting. Continue to like/share/comment on posts.

**Tours:** We did 6 last week and have 3 more this week. Combination of K and transfers. Lots of talk about changed to MPS plans. Vote is in April. I may look at other "Open House" options or add'l ads/mailers due to these changes. I try to join PK tours when I can or at least introduce myself.

**Enrollment for next Fall:** Current K numbers: 30 applied with 6 more still deciding/touring yet this week. Another 2 current families that are deciding on another year of PK vs K next Fall. Transfers update: 9 currently in the deciding phase w/3 shadowing this week.

- -Currently have 2 students confirmed not to be coming back in Fall. 16 more have asked to not be left on "continuous enrollment" but still deciding on plans
- -LADC in now in priority enrollment.
