APO updates

- Shift to thinking about virtual fundraising this year
- Moving Fun Run to spring in hopes can do it in person, have identified partner for virtual option if necessary
- Trivia Night shifting to virtual or outdoor
- Used Uniform Sale will happen but figuring out logistics
- Year of Teacher & Staff focus on recognition given expanding and challenging role in year ahead
- Actively planning First Friends Event (smaller group parties with Zoom component) and Kindergarten Popsicles event for students to meet each other

Enrollment committee updates

- o Budgeted 290/Currently enrolled at 317
- Influx of interest, tours, applications
- Few spots left in 2nd, 5th and 7th, all other grades are full with waitlists
- Kindergarten has 15 on waitlist discussion about possibility of running a 3rd class. Some concerns around space and ability to hire teacher in short timeline.
- CSCOE committed to funding development of a 360 virtual tour for website
- Producing spirit wear t-shirts and yard signs to be distributed at Back to School
