#### Introductions

## **Presidents' Report:**

- Events will look different from the past
- Read-out from ASC and coordination with Kari still trying to determine our exact needs given environment (e.g., STEM labs out / hand sanitizer IN)
- #1 priority supporting the teachers, staff appreciation / recognition
  - $\circ$  Ideas
    - 1) Having trivia night funds go 100% to teachers (gift cards, etc.)
    - 2) Other gifts / tokens of appreciation besides monetary
    - 3) Volunteers set up outdoor classroom space to make it easier on them
    - 4) Monetary bonus, gift cards, lunches provided (food trucks)
  - o Action items
    - 1) One teacher to be invited to APO meeting each month
    - 2) Class rep should have a responsibility to check in with teachers and get feedback about the specific items / support they may need; APO grade rep should also serve as "room parent" –
  - maybe have two per grade so they could divide and conquer the two classrooms, if feasible. - Other needs: Hand sanitizer and Clorox wipes
    - Ideas:
    - 1) Medical supplier
    - 2) Refilling empty canisters with a bulk supply
    - 3) "Make your own" with a bleach spray and paper towels

\*Already in process: hand sanitizer stations around school – men's group is building them Saturday morning at Keegans. Also working on a wash in / wash out station (for each classroom). K – 5 also have sinks, whilemiddle school can use bathrooms

Back to school night

- No CASH use square iPad (contactless as much as possible)

# **Officer reports**

School Advisory board

- Wait lists in every grade but two grades!
- 15 on the waitlist for kindergarten some debate about whether to add a 3<sup>rd</sup> classroom
- Volunteer commitment tabled for this year; unsure whether we can even have volunteers
- New religion curriculum that everyone is excited about!
- ASC needs two new members / last minute opening

## Treasury

- Use of "booster" program for fundraisers. Their projections likely optimistic, but we budgeted for 1/3 of the gains
- Projecting an excess of \$4K which we can use for teacher donations

## Volunteer coordinators

- Big need is classroom rep, right now waiting to hear on other needs
- Unsure if they're going to allow anyone in the school, even to clean up AFTER a break
- Substitute teacher bachelors degree required, plus a 2-day course

Health office (Teresa)

- Trying to have a nurse at school 5 days per week, 10 am 2 pm
- Copy room being converted to a "sick" room so that they no longer sit on the bench in the hallway

## **New Business**

- Fun Run moved to Spring, 2021 helps spread out the ask so kids aren't asking for money again right after Septemberfest raffle ticket sales. Virtual dance party is also being considered.
- First friends modified so that there are smaller frontyard parties with hosts + new families only
- Incoming kindergarten was restructured as playground time with your class. Kids are encouraged to wear a mask and only one parent preferred. Serving packaged cookies (instead of popsicles).
- School toolbox Total boxes sold were 152 (compared to 160) in prior years check should be coming in October for ~\$410 to APO
- Trivia night
  - o 100% virtual / there are some zoom-like companies that manage the event online
  - Drink kits / Meyers figured that out for auction pick up in church basement
  - Jen / Courtney in need of a graphic designer
  - This year, we'd like all funds to go directly to teachers (42 FT teachers do we include staff? Probably yes)
  - Idea to pair it with a "take out for good" dining option
  - Use class reps to organize teams
- Winter greens should be a good turnout this year!
