VI. New Business 7:45p.m.

- School budget and tuition discussion Deb Ferrao, Nicole Farrell, Kari Zobel
 - o Projecting enrollment of 339 next year (21/22) so flat from this year

- o Conservative projection especially if we can make the class sizes bigger again next year
- o Assumed a 3% cost of living increase for all teachers
- o Projecting around a \$300K deficit if stay in 3-5% range fo tuition increase
- o Fundraising is significantly down this year which helps fund the budget for next school year
- o Despite having strong enrollment, challenging year for fundraising will still put us in a deficient for next year
- o ASC recommends a 3% tuition increase this is a standard tuition increase and in a year when many families are being challenged financially we don't want to recommend going higher than this
- o The 3% tuition increase can fund the 3% salary increase for teachers
